Parents on game day



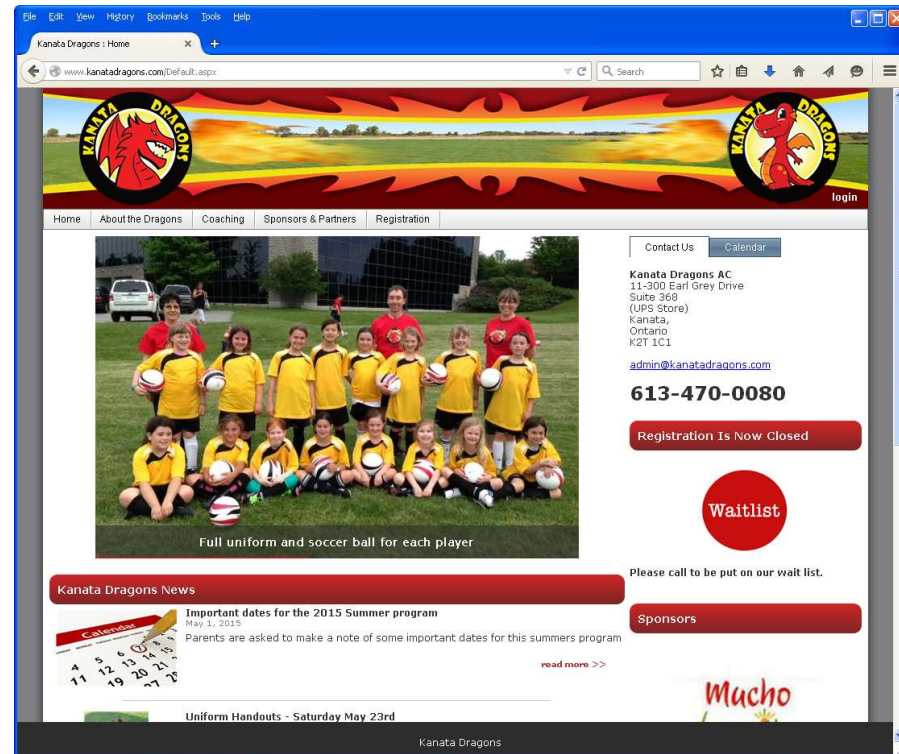
- We are not a drop off service

Parking at Brookshire Park

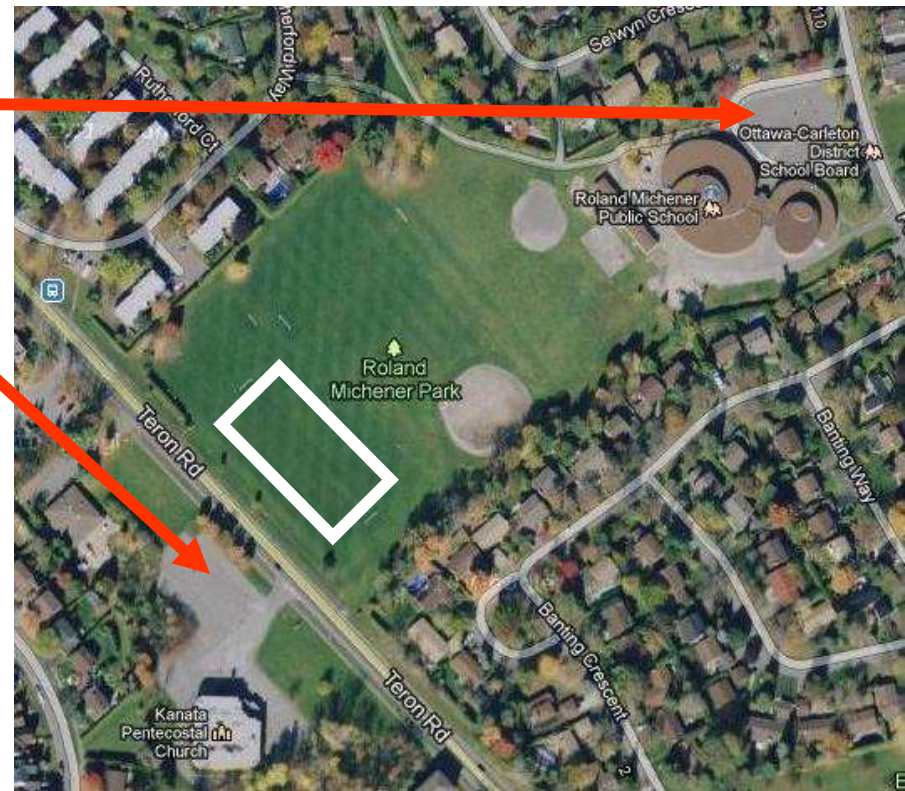
- There is a small parking area in the park

Parking at Roland Michener

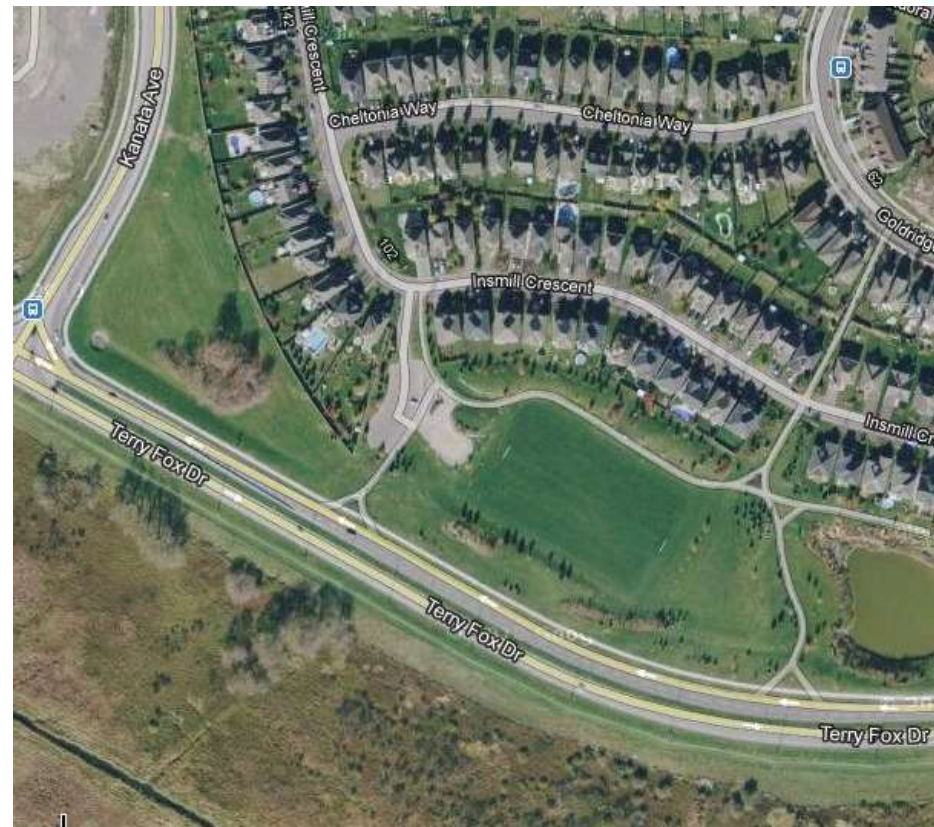
- You have two choices for parking

- The church will close the parking lot if there is a church event scheduled for that day
- Use street parking if the lots are full
- There are 3 fields at Roland Michener School. Our field is shown in white



Parking at Insmill Park

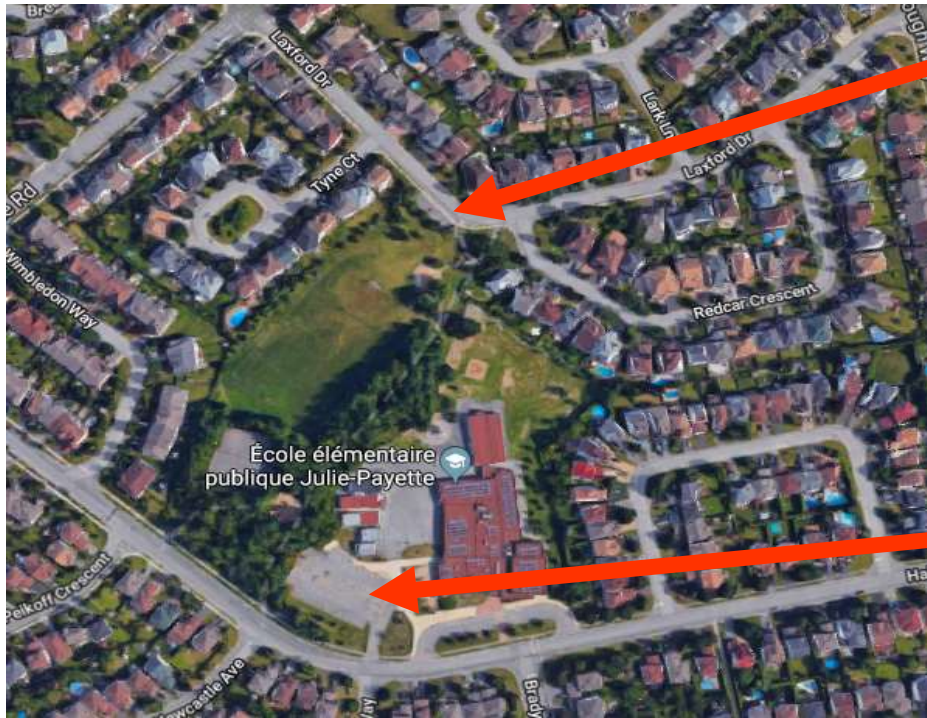


- The parking lot is small at Insmill Park (approximately 20 cars)
- Expect to park on the street
- You can not access this field from Terry Fox Drive
- If you are driving on Terry Fox turn onto Kanata Avenue and then turn right into the housing estate until you reach Insmill Crescent
- Please do not park on Terry Fox Drive





Parking at Klondike Park



- There is limited parking on Laxford Drive
