Snacks



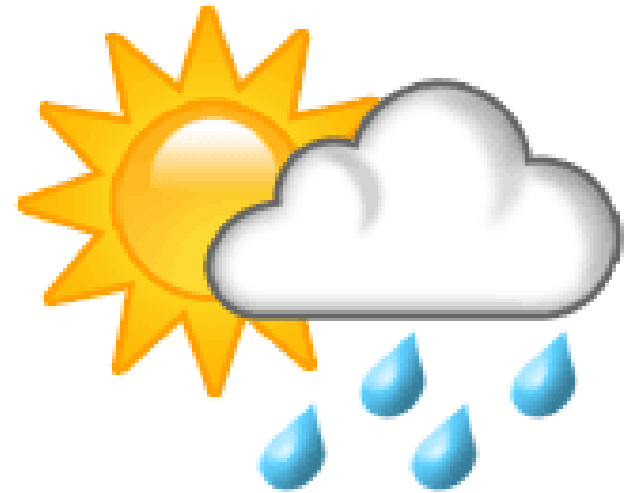
- It is club policy that coaches do not organize the snack roster

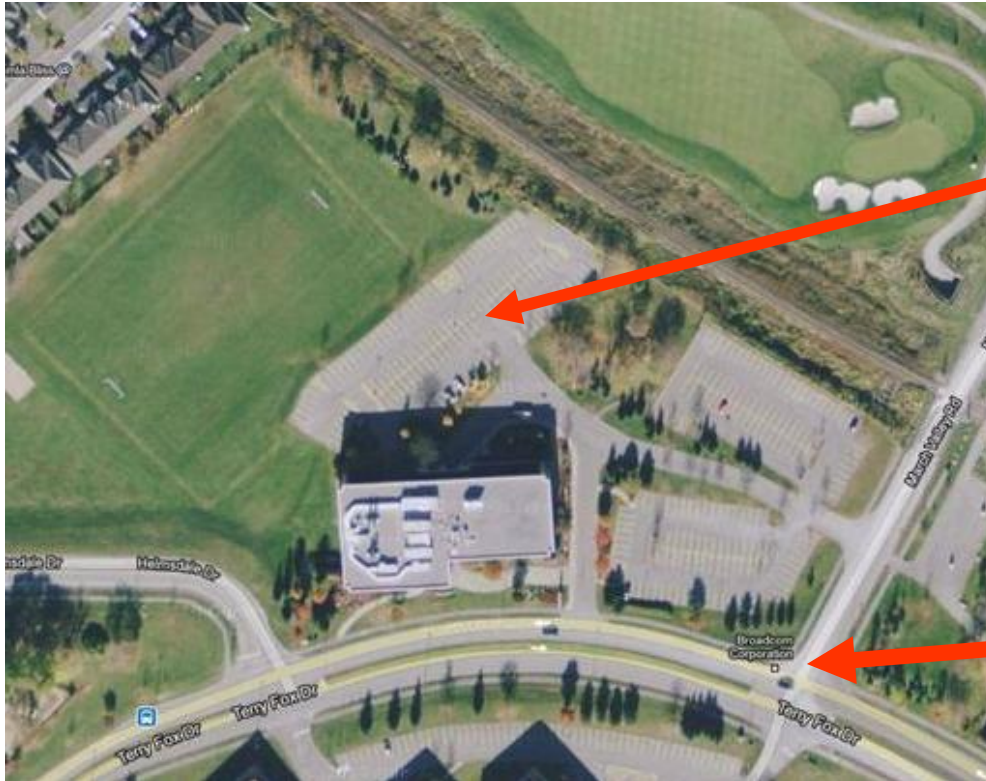

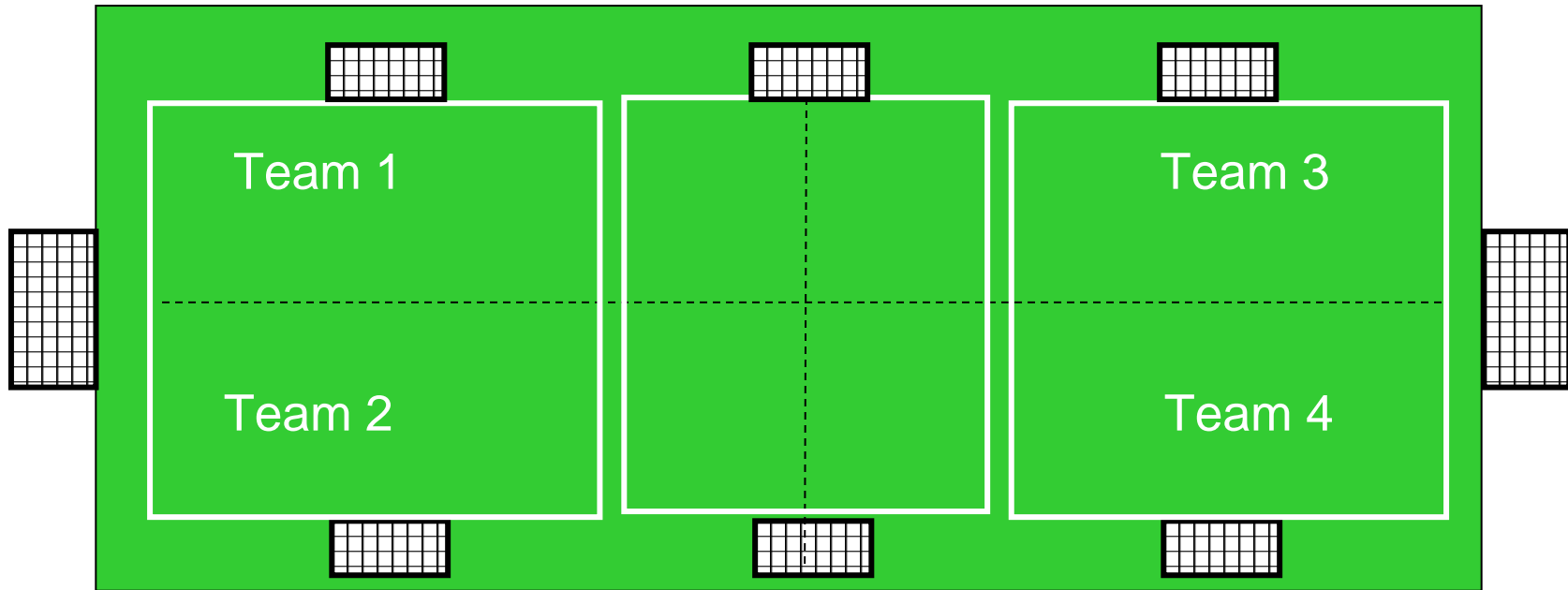


- Use the parking lot adjacent to the field

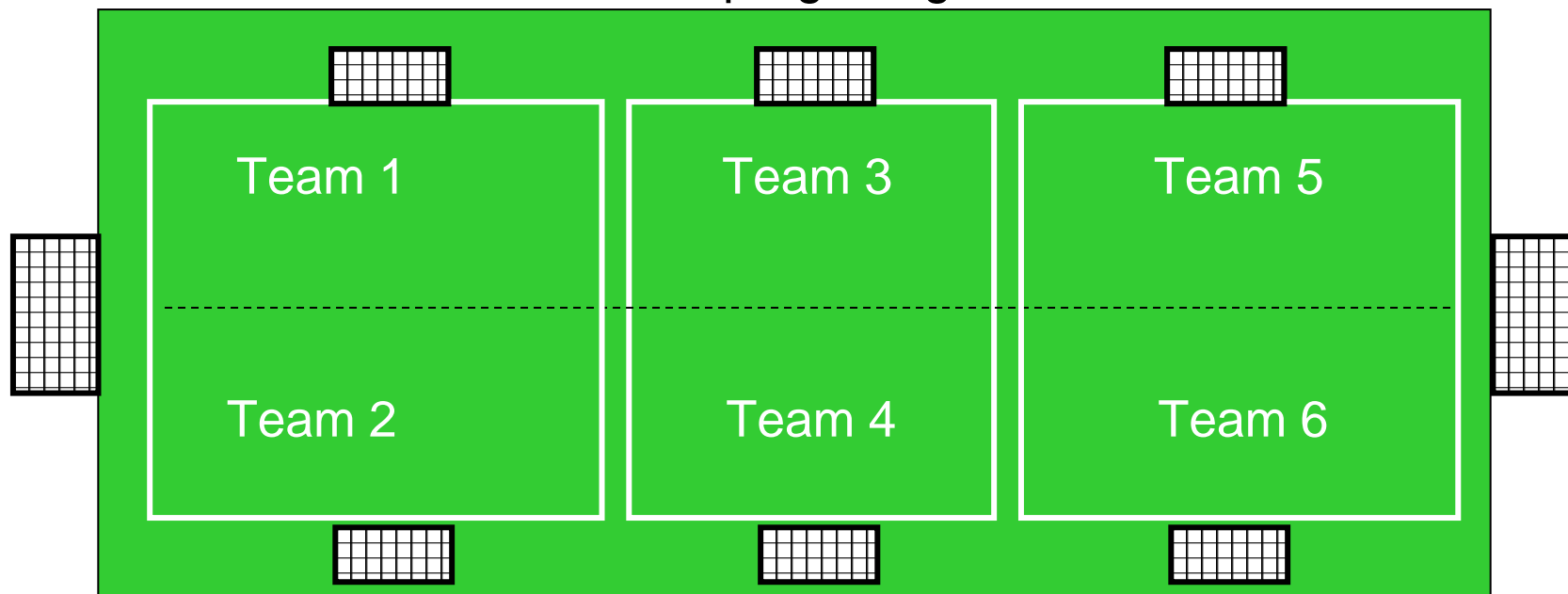

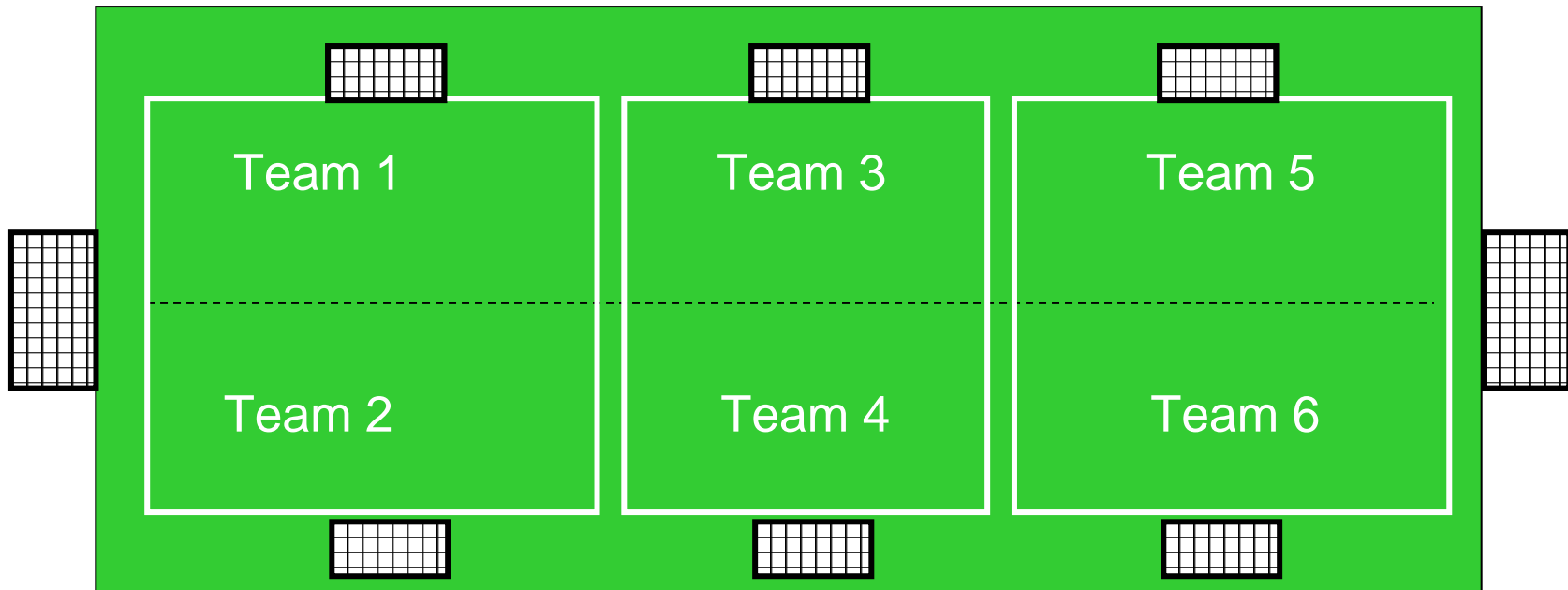

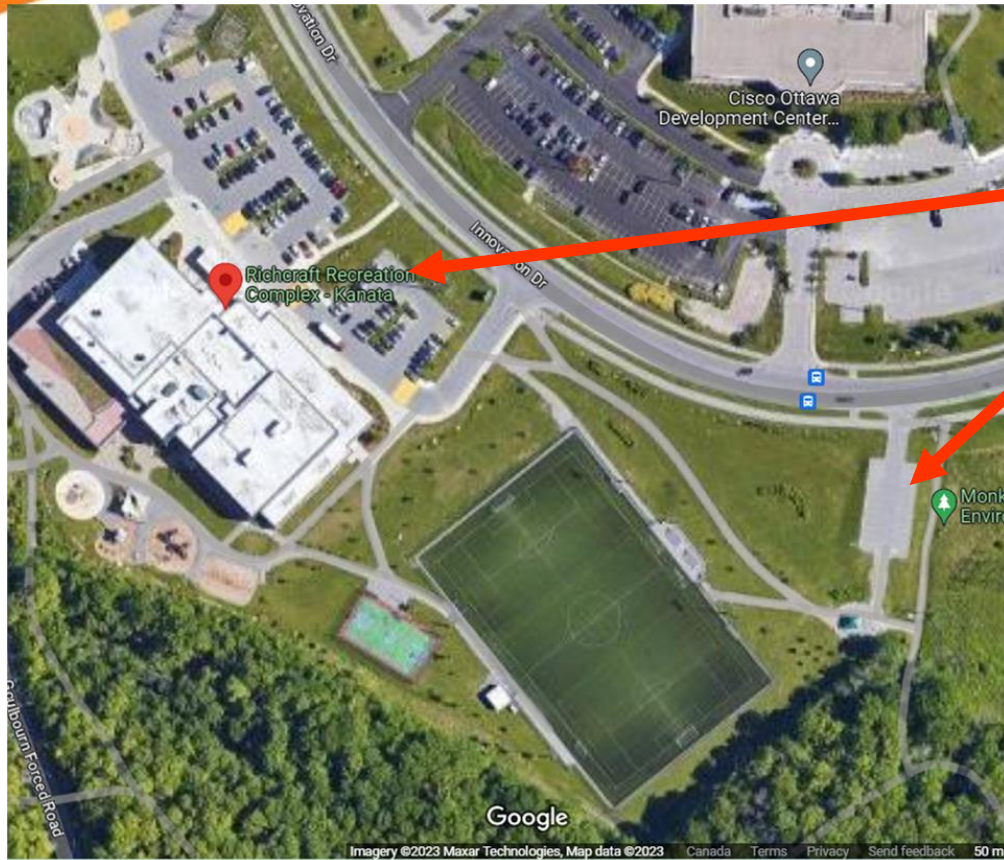

Parking at Richcraft

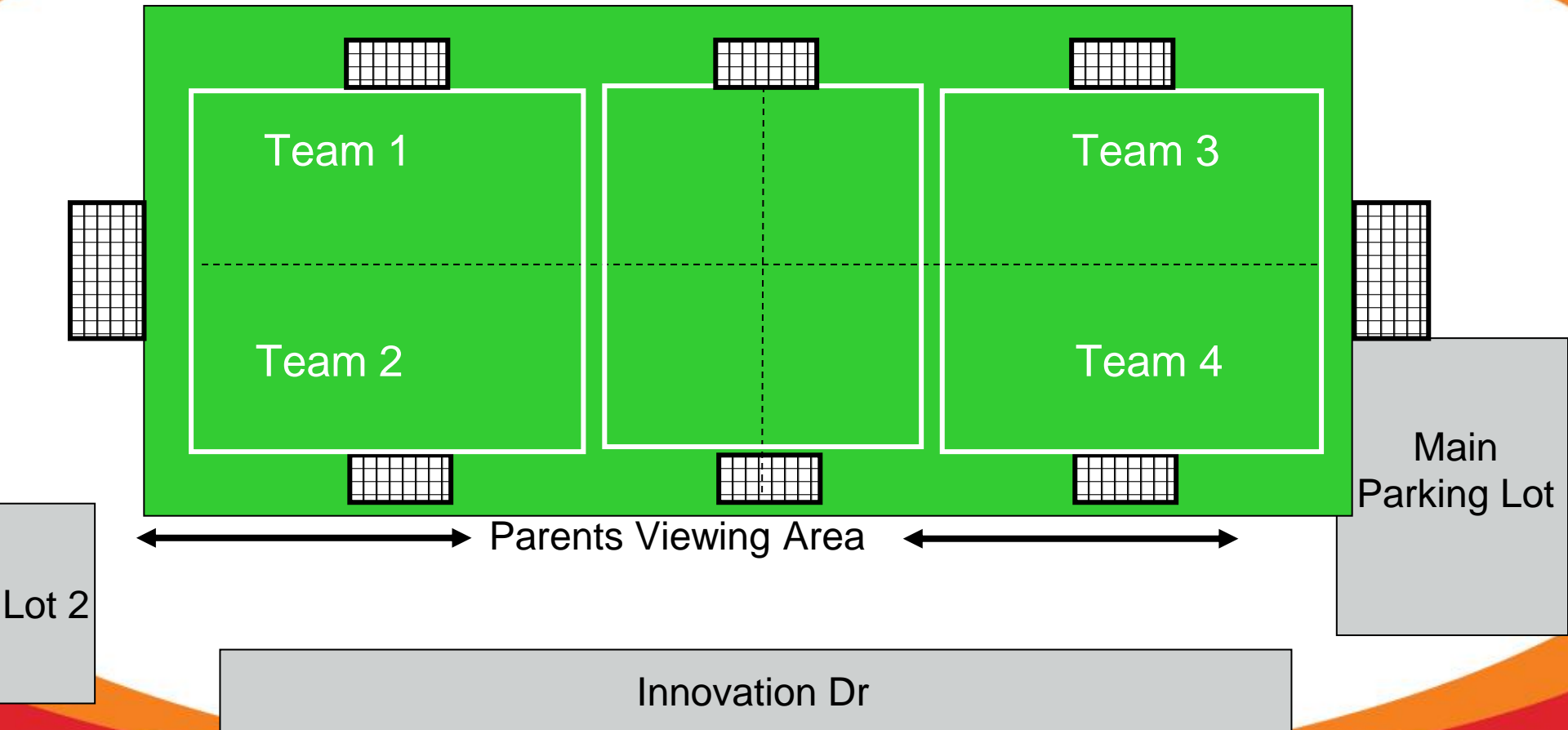


- You have two choices for parking:

Parking at Roland Michener



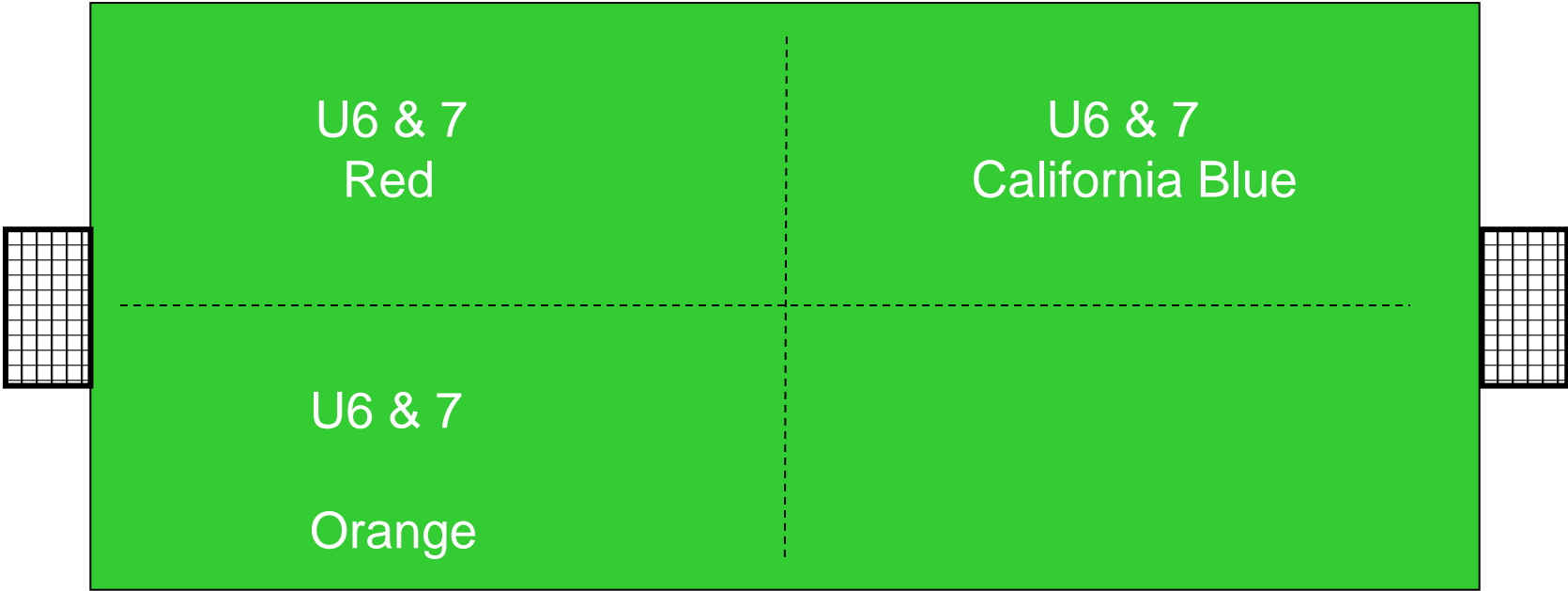
- You have two choices for parking

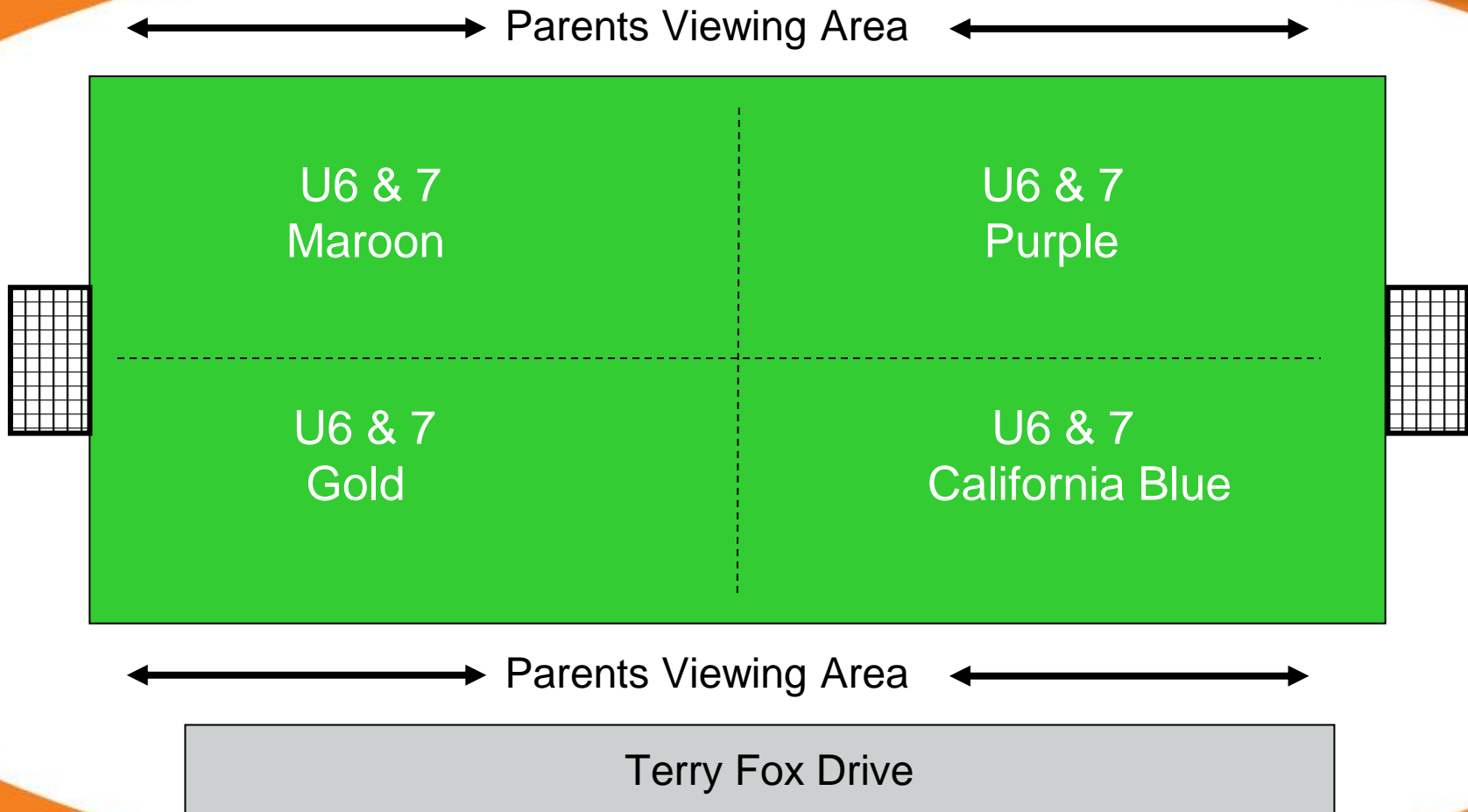
Parking at Insmill Park



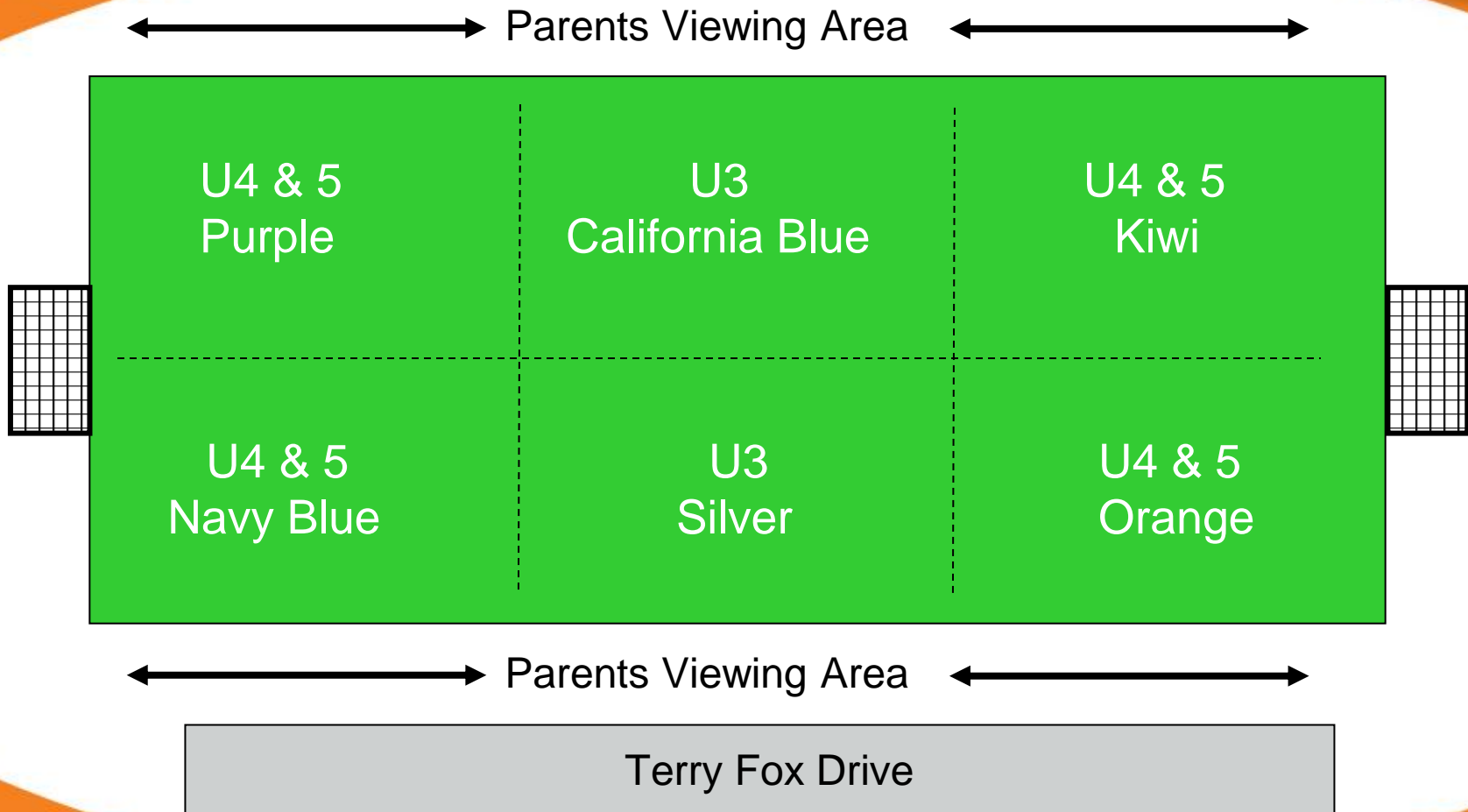
- The parking lot is small at Insmill Park (approximately 20 cars)

- Please do not park on Terry Fox Drive



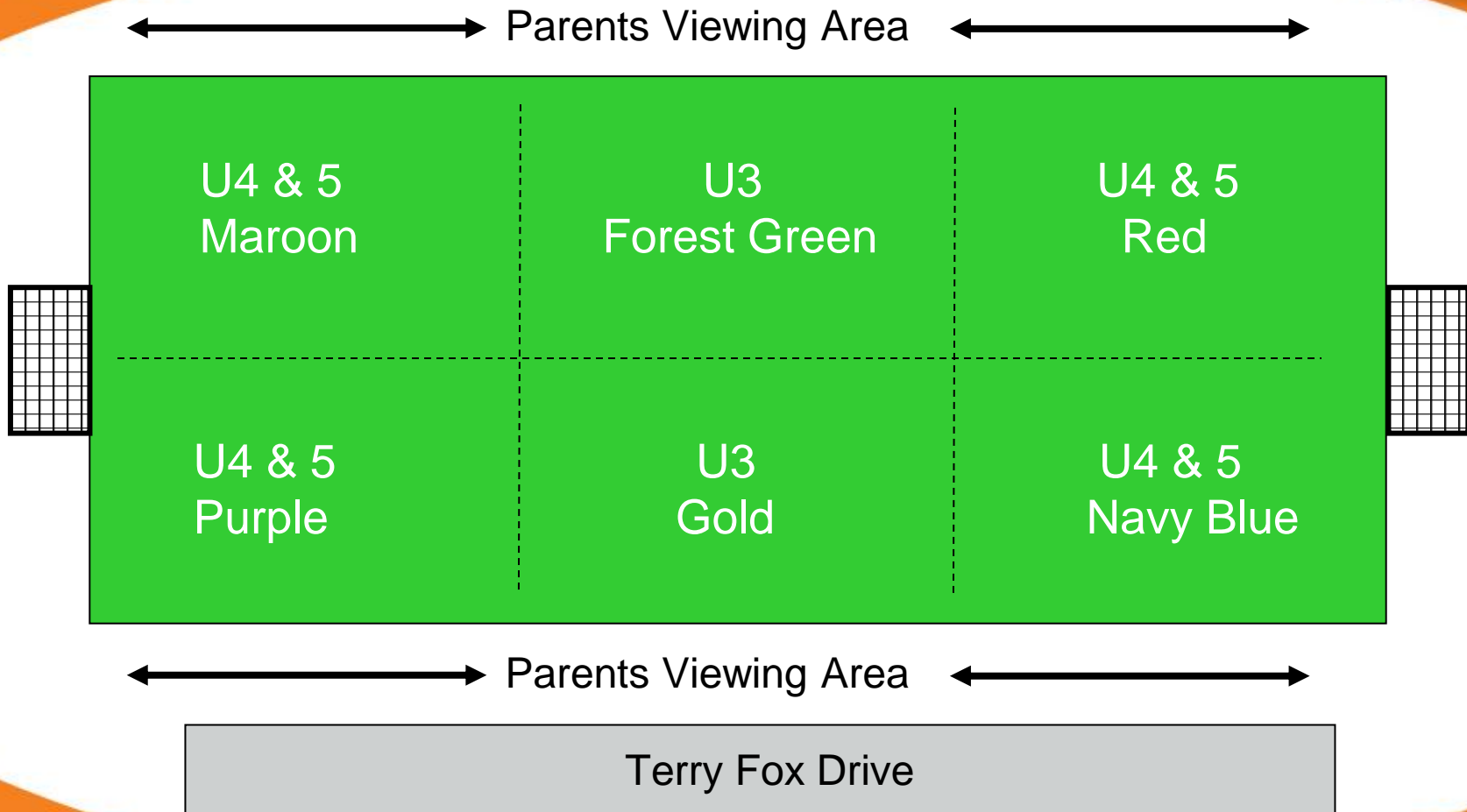

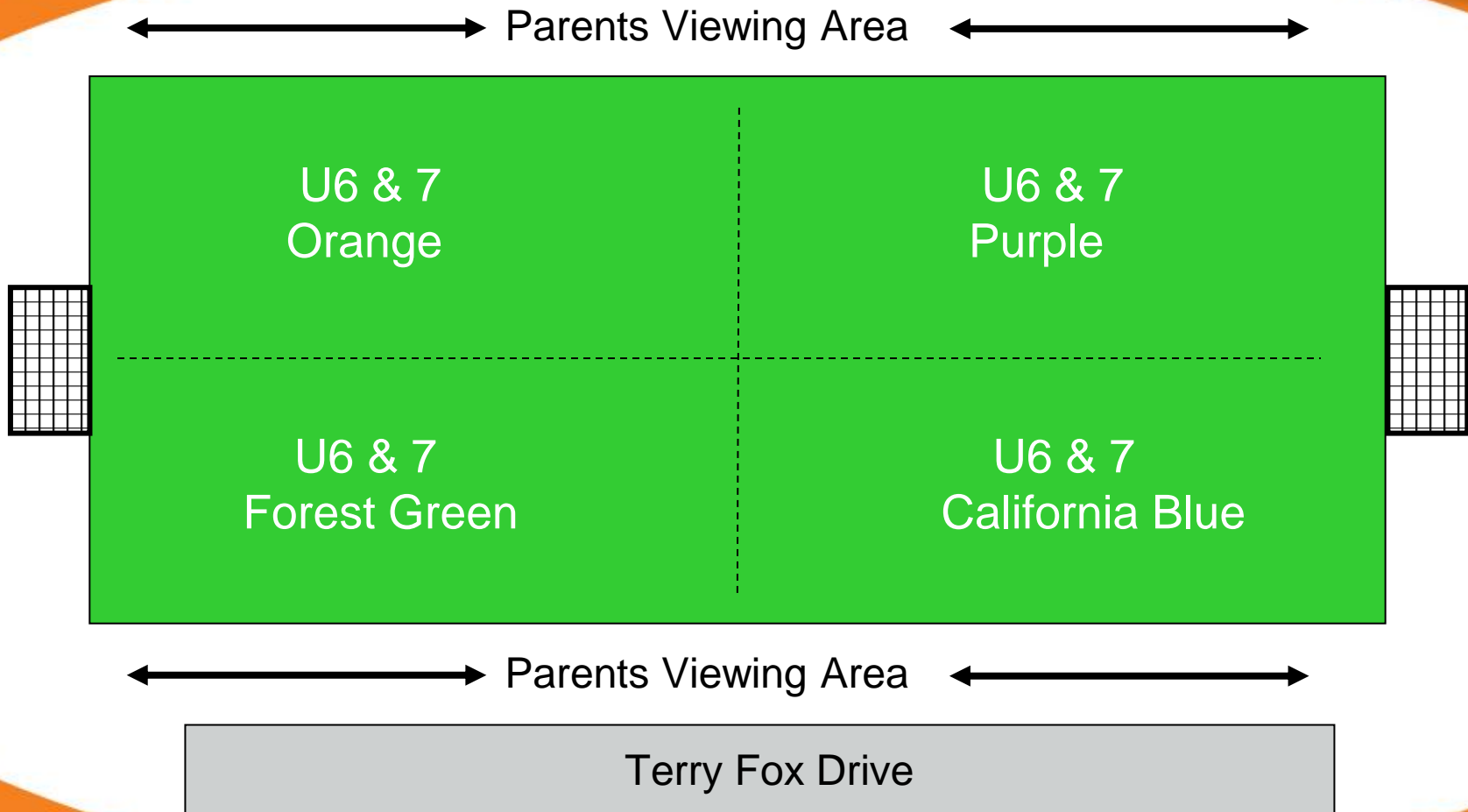
Insmill Park – Tuesday

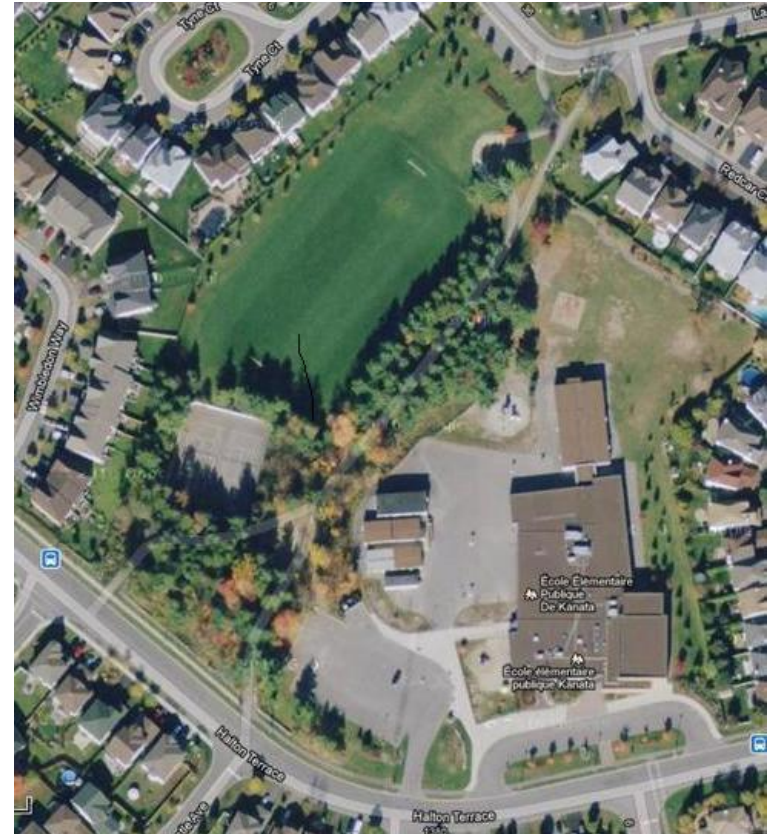
